#### **AET EXAMPLE JOURNAL**

In AET, Use the following protocol:

**Activity Name** - Use the Ohio level of competition followed by the CDE name

**Type** - Select the most accurate CDE from the dropdown

**Level** - Select the most accurate level of competition

**FOR STATE EVENTS - Use AET Calendar**

**NOTE:** Chapter = chapter or county competitions

District = Sub-district AND District competitions

Extended Travel Trips = National Finals/Multi-State
