

## NATURE'S CLASSROOM CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

As an outdoor education program, we will be spending a considerable amount of time outdoors. Use discretion depending on the length of stay and time of the year. **All suggested items should be marked with the student's name.**

Please pack sleeping bags and pillows in a plastic bag or luggage. Loose articles may get wet. It is nice to pack a few extra plastic bags for packing to go home. Remember to label **all** items of clothing and luggage. All campers are responsible for their belongings. Ohio FFA Camp Muskingum assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen articles.

### Bedding
