JOIN THE KROGER COMMUNITY REWARDS PROGRAM

When you are ready to renew your vehicle registration, contact your local Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) or go online at [oplates.com](https://www.oplates.com). Just ask for the "Agricultural Education" or "Future Farmer" plate. With each renewal, you'll be making a tax-deductible donation to support the Ohio FFA Foundation.

All of the funds raised through the license plate program are used to support members through statewide programs such as: Career Development Events, proficiency awards, leadership nights and the Ohio FFA Convention.
