- Travel for state employees is restricted to mission critical requirements.

Membership Guidance

- Student enrolled in courses for an Office of Career-Technical Education approved program shall have access to their aligned CTSO regardless of delivery method.
- Must meet minimum/maximum courses requirements.



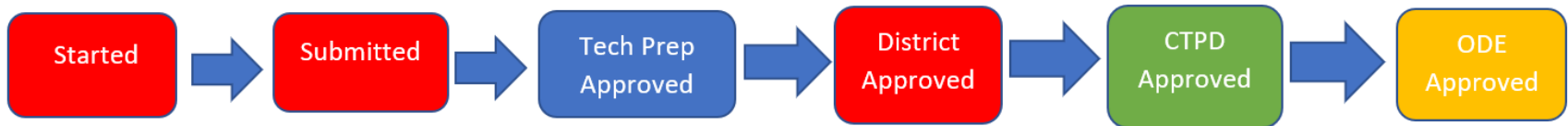

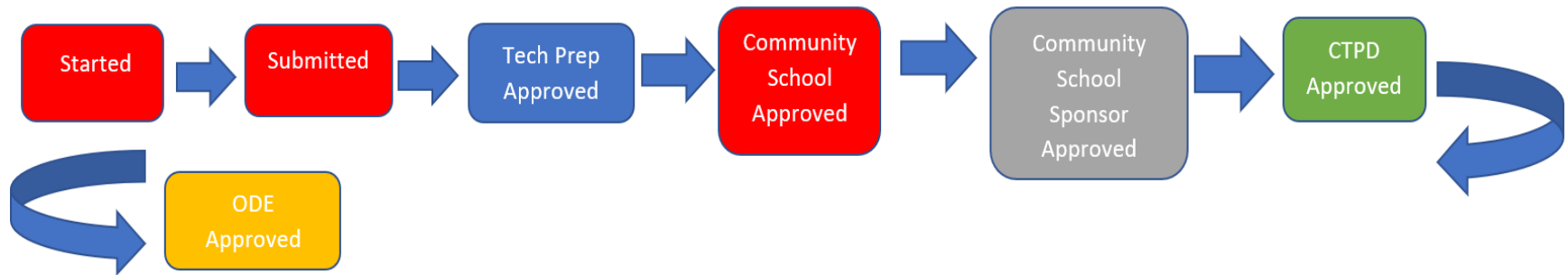

Local District or Joint Vocational School District Approved Application

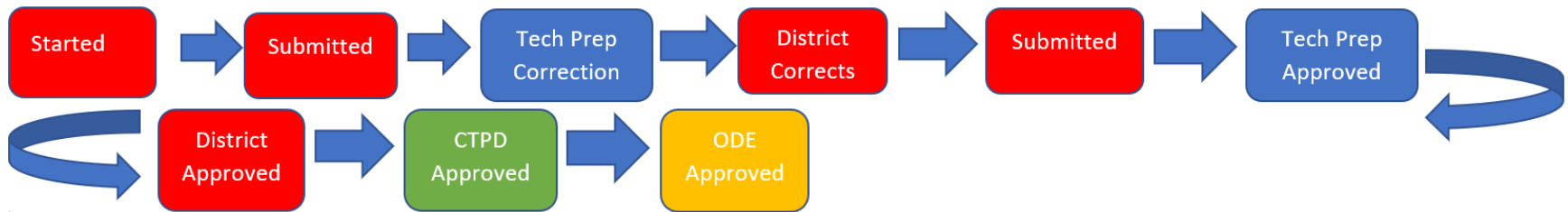


Community School or STEM School Approved Application

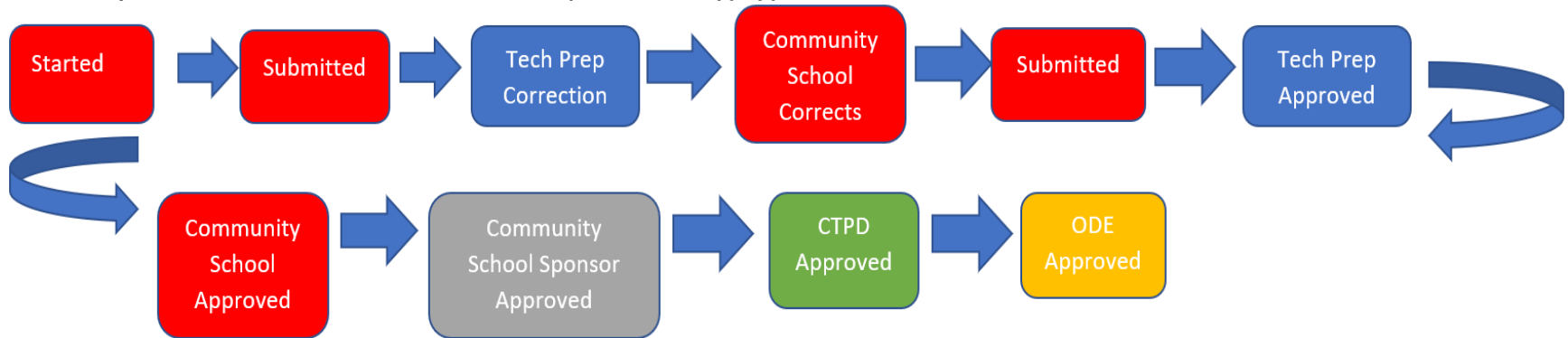

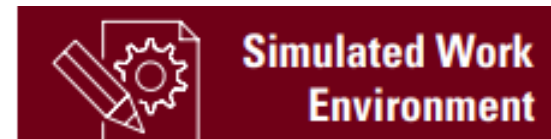
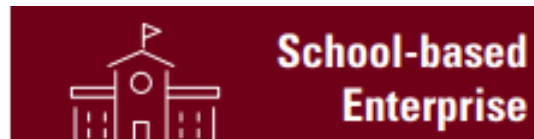
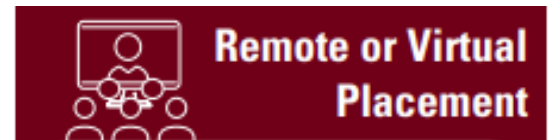
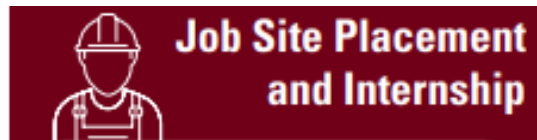
Work Based Learning

From the [CTE Data & Accountability Guidebook](#):

Beginning as early as grade 9, CTE students should accumulate 250 hours of work-based learning experience aligned to their program of study with evidence of positive evaluations.

(Aligned to new graduation requirements.)

Experiences may include one or more of the following:



Work Based Learning

Work-Based Learning Requirements:

1. Work-based learning experiences must occur at work sites.
 - Work site can also exist virtually or within the school.
 - Should not occur during instructional time OR overlap with teacher-led activities.
 - Should include regular interaction with community members/customers/clients.

Work Based Learning

Work-Based Learning Requirements:

2. Work-based learning experiences must be co-supervised by an instructor/educational representative and an employer/business mentor.
3. A [Learning Agreement](#) built on professional, academic and technical competencies aligned to the student's program of study must be in place.

Evaluation Process

- Electronic Submission Portal
 - District, State (includes Region currently)
- Application + Interactive Records will load in the submission
 - Paper records will upload in google doc
- Records will be reviewed
- Feedback provided for edits/corrections
- At District Level, number of submissions is a District decision

Evaluation Process

- Electronic Check Sheet will be used for the records submitted
- Application is included in the portal for reference
- Electronic feedback will populate in the sticky note for edits (Approved or Returned)
- Returned apps – correct and resubmit
- Competitive applications
 - DUE once **Feb. 12th 11:59 PM**(Date Corrected)

Evaluation Process


- **Pre-Evaluation** (Evaluators – District Decision)
 - Submission portal
 - Multiple submissions – district discretion
- **Regional** (Evaluators – Sign Up/Apps Assigned)
 - One-time submission
 - State Degrees – Accepted -----Done
 - State Degrees – Returned ----- submit for State Evaluation

Evaluations Continued

- **State** (Evaluator Sign Up – Apps Assigned)
 - One-time submission
 - ALL American Degrees – checked 3x
 - State Degree – Correction apps only
 - Any corrections (State/American) after State Evaluation are submitted at \$35
 - ALL Competitive Applications scored
 - Proficiency
 - State/American Stars
