

# MEMBER HIRED FOR FULL-TIME JOB RECEIVES SIGNING BONUS

On stage at the 94<sup>th</sup> Ohio FFA Convention, Kayla Cummins of the Indian Lake FFA was recognized as one of five RISE FFA Program participants. It was announced live that she would be receiving a Jeep Gladiator Truck as a signing bonus in addition to her full-time employment at Sunrise Cooperative. The Indian Lake FFA chapter will also receive \$1,000 to help enhance their local FFA program.

Cummins' truck is one year old. It was driven by the 2021-2022 Ohio FFA President, Jake Zajkowski, and served as safe and reliable transportation during his year as president.

# **BLUE JACKETS**

#### PROVIDING A MORE ACCESSIBLE FFA EXPERIENCE



Each year the Ohio FFA Foundation helps first-year members obtain FFA jackets. Students from across Ohio either applied or were nominated to be a part of the Blue Jackets program, sponsored by Beck's Hybrids. In fall 2021, through the nomination process, eight members of the Aiken FFA Chapter, an urban program located in Cincinnati, were awarded funds for jackets. Students in the chapter are from 37 countries around the world and speak 35 different languages. Overall, students have little previous experience with agriculture – if any.

The Aiken FFA Chapter is in its first year and was led by first-year teacher, Samantha McAllister. At the beginning of the school year, McAllister learned to be creative when teaching her culturally diverse students about the blue and gold.

"I introduced my students to FFA by bringing in my FFA jacket and sharing the stories and memories I created while wearing it," said McAllister.

Shortly after learning more about FFA, McAllister said her students eagerly began asking questions on how to become more involved in the organization. At the local level, Aiken FFA members care for the school farm consisting of 35 raised vegetation beds and livestock. They also manage the chapter's coffee shop. The students conduct the maintenance and business practices of both entities.

"Through classwork and taking care of their Supervised Agricultural Experiences, I saw my students realize that FFA isn't just a farm thing, but an everybody thing," said McAllister.

Her students' excitement grew as they learned more about Career Development Events, available leadership opportunities, and the chances to travel to both the national and state FFA conventions.

Though her students come from various backgrounds, they are now tied together by the thread of the blue corduroy. Many of the chapter's community supporters are excited to see the students' growth and achievements in the coming months and years.

"The jacket has become the way that our students can go and do. I can't wait to see what Aiken FFA members have in store for their futures while wearing their very own jackets," said McAllister.

# CHAPTER SPOTLIGHT

**PEEBLES FFA** 



For the past decade, Peebles FFA members in Adams County have raised broiler chickens in the classroom as a project to learn about meat and animal sciences. When she first implemented this hands-on learning experience into her classes, agricultural educator and FFA advisor, Rebecca Minton didn't realize this project would cultivate an experience more impactful and meaningful than she ever thought possible.

In 2021, Minton applied for and received an Ohio FFA Foundation Agricultural & Rural Community Outreach Program (ARCOP) grant on behalf of her chapter. Originally introduced in 2013, ARCOP grants allow FFA chapters to apply for funding that aid community development projects and provide support in building sustainable relationships and programs. ARCOP grants are made possible by a partnership between the Ohio FFA Foundation and the Ohio Department of Agriculture.

The Peebles chapter was also awarded a \$25,000 grant from the Southern Ohio Agricultural and Community Development Foundation. With the total funds, Minton's goal was to further her students' understanding of meat science and the farm-to-table experience – all while creating a project that her students could make their own.

After talking with Matthew Hudgel and Darby Mills, chapter president and chapter vice president, respectively, Minton decided to use the grant to purchase meat processing equipment that would not only help educate her students but also support the local community. In fall 2021, the Peebles FFA Chapter donated approximately 50 broilers to a local food pantry. In the last decade, they have donated more than 500 whole broilers for those in need.

"By having our harvesting and processing system in place, each student will have a hands-on experience and learn about food safety, meat cuts and proper storage requirements. We want all our student members to be smart consumers who can utilize these skills later in life," said Hudgel.

Peebles FFA members have hopes to continue to grow their impact in the future. Currently, the chapter raises broilers once a year. With these grants, it is now possible for Peebles FFA to raise broilers multiple times throughout the school year.

"We have hopes of starting a co-op. We have also discussed ways for our project to educate our community. One way in doing this is having members of our community tour our processing facility and for our chapter members to teach them how we raise, butcher, process, and package our broilers," said Mills.



# COLLEGE STUDENTS PREPARE TO ENTER THE CLASSROOM AS AG EDUCATORS

In the fall of 2021, nearly 30 college students with plans of pursuing careers as agricultural educators gathered at the Ohio FFA Center for a day of professional development. Attendees were able to meet state staff members and peers from Central State University, The Ohio State University, The Ohio State University ATI and Wilmington College. These future teachers took a closer look at the agricultural education three-circle model which is comprised of classroom/laboratory, supervised agricultural experiences or work-based learning and participation in FFA. This event as well as other teacher retention and recruitment efforts are made possible by Ohio Corn & Wheat.



#### **CLYDE FFA ADVISOR RECEIVES TOP HONOR**

To shed light on the contributions of Ohio's leading agricultural teachers, Ohio FFA, Nationwide, Ohio Farm Bureau, Farm Credit Mid-America and AgCredit, ACA recognized Barrett Zimmerman of Clyde FFA as the 2021-2022 Ohio Agricultural Educator of the Year. Zimmerman has taught for 29 years and has worked to build and maintain relationships with students, community organizations and local businesses.

A student who nominated Zimmerman wrote, "Mr. Zimmerman, otherwise known as 'Z,' always goes out of his way. No matter who the student is, he makes sure they have the best experience! He always

wants to make sure that the kids who join our ag program are active, and he gives us many opportunities to do that."

In addition to the Ohio Agricultural Educator of the Year title, Zimmerman received the coveted Golden Owl Award trophy and the Clyde FFA Chapter received a \$3,000 Nationwide-funded donation to support its agricultural education program.

# FFA MEMBER Q&A





#### WHAT IS YOUR SUPERVISED AGRICULTURAL EXPERIENCE (SAE)?

"My SAE is the production and sale of maple syrup, a family tradition on our farm for the past five generations. I'm excited to be the sixth generation to carry it on. This SAE has helped me learn so many life skills that otherwise I would not have. In the past, we typically tapped around 400 trees. However, I wanted a challenge and tapped 1,000. That is the most significant number of trees we have ever tapped. Once you start an operation that big, you have to get many others to help you and you need to be an effective communicator."

#### WHAT IS YOUR FAVORITE CAREER DEVELOPMENT EVENT (CDE)?

"My favorite CDE is Parliamentary Procedure because it was my first CDE that I got to participate in. It's a CDE that my siblings and dad also participated in when they were in FFA. Parli Pro also feels like family because everyone on the team has to work closely together to ensure a successful meeting."

#### WHAT IS YOUR FAVORITE CHAPTER ACTIVITY?

"My favorite FFA activity is the community project our chapter does around the holidays, which we call "Gifts of Love," for our county nursing home residents. It is exciting to see the looks on the residents' faces when they see us arrive with gifts. This year, we were some of their first visitors since the pandemic started, so you can imagine the excitement they had."

#### **HOW HAS FFA IMPACTED YOUR LIFE?**

"FFA has provided me with so many opportunities and has always been there for me when I had a bad day. The ag classroom is the room that I always look forward to entering because I know that no matter what we're doing that day, I'm going to learn something life-changing."
